Director's Notes

I would like to thank Barb Mulligan, Debbie Love and the Board of Director's of the Theatre Guild for giving me the opportunity to once again direct at the Guild.

Working in any capacity in theatre can either be a joyous blessing or an unimaginable nightmare. For me, this production of PICASSO AT THE LAPIN AGILE has been most joyous. I recently mentioned to the actors that every director should have to act now and again and every actor should face the challenges of directing a show and all of us should have to spend time learning how to run lights, sound and costumes in order to become better well-rounded theatricians.
